Last Week – Brookland-Cayce ran into Region 5-3A buzzsaw Strom Thurmond at The Cage and dropped a 35-7 decision to the three time defending region champions ... Rebels quarterback **Aramis Hillary** rushed for 89 yards, passed for 216 yards, and produced five touchdowns for Strom Thurmond ... Hillary threw a pair of touchdowns and scored on runs of 2, 19, and 47 yards ... B-C got on the board in the third quarter when quarterback **Kenyatta Castleberry** hooked up with wideout **Jonathan Rumph** for a 17-yard score and placekicker **Robby Setzler** tacked on the PAT ... Chapin withstood a late rally by Midland Valley to claim a 14-12 victory at Langley ... The Eagles scored touchdowns in the second and third quarters and made it stand up as the Mustangs scored twice in the final stanza.

Chapin Series – The Bearcats lead the seven game series with the Eagles 4-3 ... B-C and Chapin have split the four games as region foes and the Eagles hold a 2-1 advantage at Cecil Woolbright Stadium ... The average score in this series has been B-C 17-14 Chapin ... The Lexington County rivals have met every season since 2000 ... Chapin will remain in Region 4-3A next year, but will be members of the Upper State along with Chester, Fairfield Central, A.C. Flora, Lower Richland, and Lugoff-Elgin ... Conversely, B-C will move to the Lower State's Region 5 along with Airport, Dreher, Midland Valley, South Aiken, and Swansea.

Eye on the Eagles –

The Eagles are in the exact spot that Chapin was in last year at 3-4 overall, but this year **Coach Larry Grady's** second CHS squad is 1-1 in the region as opposed to an 0-2 mark last season ... Chapin relies on a ground game powered by running back **Jonathan Darden** (790 yards) and backfield mate **Tom Atkinson** (nearly 400 yards) ... **Xan Taylor** leads the defensive troops with more than 60 tackles and **Adam Curtis** is active along the defensive front ... The special teams unit is anchored by mammoth kicker **Haze Weinspach**, who doubles as a defensive tackle for the Eagles ... Chapin is 2-2 at home this year.

Next Game – B-C will hit the road for the final time during the regular season as the Bearcats will take on Midland Valley in Langley ... The Bearcats and Mustangs have played every year as region rivals since MVHS was opened in 1980 ... Brookland-Cayce and Midland Valley were members of Class 4A from 1980-95 before joining Class 3A in 1996 ... Midland Valley leads the series 16-11, but B-C has won four straight and five of the last seven ... At Langley, the Mustangs hold a 9-4 advantage while at Cayce the series is tied 7-7.
